Site Progress Update -
Bridge Street
Chelmsford
CM1



Bridge Street CM1 is now entering its final stages, with excellent progress made across the site. Green roofing works have been fully completed, offering a striking outlook that can be enjoyed directly from the master bedroom. Internally, the staircase has been clad in timber flooring, incorporating a refined shadow gap detail, with spindles scheduled for installation shortly. Internal finishes are continuing at pace, including the installation of timber cladding, internal wall cladding, and the fit-out of the kitchen and ensuite, bringing the scheme ever closer to completion and highlighting the quality and attention to detail throughout the development.



Westbourne Grove, Notting Hill

This project is nearing completion and marks the successful redevelopment of a historic mid-terrace building in the heart of this vibrant retail and dining district. The scheme combines high-quality ground-floor commercial accommodation with residential space above, with a strong focus on sensitive refurbishment and modernisation. Works include a new shopfront, replacement double-glazed timber windows, enhanced architectural detailing and a new rear conservatory structure, all designed to respect the conservation area context. The ground floor (approx. 1,399 sq ft) and basement (approx. 430 sq ft) provide flexible Class E commercial space suitable for restaurant, café or retail use, delivered with a fully refurbished frontage and open-plan interior supported by approved structural upgrades.

In summary, Westbourne Grove is being repositioned as a refreshed and flexible commercial unit with complementary residential accommodation above. The redevelopment strengthens its retail and street presence on one of Notting Hill's key commercial thoroughfares while significantly improving functionality and quality, all delivered in compliance with heritage, conservation and planning requirements.
