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New Project - Echo House NW6

Green Street, London W1K

JPD has been appointed to deliver a split-level, super-prime apartment in the heart of Mayfair. The property has been stripped back to its original brickwork to facilitate a complete refurbishment, including the installation of new MEP systems, as well as comprehensive acoustic and thermal upgrades.

The apartment incorporates a number of exceptional bespoke features, including a spiral marble-clad staircase, seamless polished plaster finishes throughout, a designer kitchen, and a luxury steam shower.

The project is scheduled for completion in late summer 2026.



Streatley Place, Hampstead NW3



Works are now underway at Streatley Place, NW3 marking an exciting milestone as the project enters the reinforced concrete and steel frame interface stage.

The first steel members are being lifted into position and precisely integrated with the existing RC structure, bringing the building's framework to life and driving forward a major step in its structural progression on site.

A new phase of transformation has commenced at Riverside House in Woolwich, marking the launch of an exciting new project for JPD Corporation Ltd. The site is being thoroughly secured, with comprehensive boarding measures ensuring both safety and protection as works progress.

Following the completion of a detailed asbestos survey, specialist teams are undertaking the precise and compliant removal of hazardous materials across both buildings, adhering strictly to all regulatory standards.

In tandem with this, a full internal strip-out is underway, removing all existing finishes and clearing the structures back to their core. Once complete, the buildings will stand clean, stable, and secure—prepared for the next stage of their evolution.
